



YouTube Casting Instructions

The primary requirement is that both your casting device (phone/PC) and your TV (or streaming device) must be connected to the same Wi-Fi network.

Method 1: Casting from a Mobile Device (iOS or Android)

1. Open the **YouTube app** on your phone or tablet.
2. Tap the **Cast icon** (a rectangle with a Wi-Fi symbol). You can find this in the top right corner of your screen or at the bottom of the video player.
3. Select your **TV or streaming device** from the list that appears.
4. The video should begin playing on your TV automatically. You can now use your phone as a remote to pause, play, or queue videos.

Method 2: Casting from a Computer (Chrome)

1. Open your web browser (Google Chrome) and go to **YouTube**.
2. Click on the video you want to watch.
3. Click the **Cast icon** located in the bottom right of the video player, or click the **Cast icon** in your browser's toolbar (often in the top right corner of the browser).
4. Select your TV from the device list

Method 3: Linking with a TV Code (If Wi-Fi casting isn't working)

If your devices are on different Wi-Fi networks (such as on a hotel or guest network), you can still pair them using a code:

1. Open the YouTube app on your TV.
2. Go to **Settings** and select **Link with TV code**. A blue, multi-digit code will appear on the screen.
3. Open the YouTube app on your phone, tap the **Cast icon**, then tap **Link with TV code**.
4. Enter the blue code shown on your TV and tap **Link**
